BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR V.C.C. ENTRANTS:

- 1. All entrants and drivers must be financial members of the V.C.C. of NZ Inc.
- 2. Vehicles must have a V.C.C. Identity Card and Log Book or MSNZ equivalent.
- 3. Drivers require V.C.C. Historic Racing Licence or MSNZ equivalent.
- 4. Crash Helmet to an approved specification:

NZ5430

Australia: AS1698.

Britain: BS6658-85 type A (Blue Label) valid for 10 yrs past manufacture Snell Foundation: Snell SA 2005 and later, M2005 and later K2005 and later. Europe: "E" mark Homologation numbers 04,05,06,07,etc. followed by the manufactures production number. (The first two digits represent the year of the series amendments and will advance each calendar year) **Note**: the number within "E" mark circle is not the year of manufacture but is the approving country's number and should not be confused with the homologation numbers which are beneath or after the "E" mark circle.

- 5. Overalls must be a minimum of flameproof two layer or single layer with woollen underwear and socks, gloves, footwear minimum of leather shoes, no canvas shoes.
- 6. Entries will be limited to pre 1965 vehicles. All cars entered must accurately represent this period of motor sport. Modifications with later out of period parts are unlikely to be accepted. Some exceptions may be granted at the discretion of the VCC Officials, please seek approval prior to the event.
- 7. Tyres: GENERAL: Tyre compound and construction must respect the specifications that were applicable to the period the vehicle represents. Chassis and suspension componentry were designed to accept the loads and forces induced by tyres of any given period. To install a tyre of improved technology could impose loadings that exceed the chassis and suspension design parameters.

RACE TYRE FOR CIRCUIT RACING AND SPEED EVENTS:

Cars in period 1931 to 1971 must use Dunlop Vintage or L or M section racing tyres which have 204 compound only and tread pattern CR65 or earlier. Alternately, Hoosier VFF Tyres models 44165, 44405 and 44408 may be used.

ROAD TYRES:

All Cars may as an alternative to using period racing tyres use tyres suitable for legal road use (i.e.DOT approved road tyres having 2mm minimum tread depth across 75% of the width of the tyre and around the entire circumference of the tyre. Aspect ratio is restricted to 70% minimum.

THE TREAD PATTERN <u>MUST</u> BE IN KEEPING WITH THE PERIOD THE VEHICLE REPRESENTS: Any road tyre used in a race or speed event <u>MUST</u> have a speed rating compatible with capability of the car.

- 8. Post 1960 open cars require an approved roll bar and safety harness.
- 9. Entered cars must be of a high standard of overall condition.
